
Subject: - Modification of End User Certificate - Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for issue of Authorization by Ministry of Defence, Department of Defence Production for Export of Munitions List Items by both Private as well as Public Sector Units as notified by DGFT under Category 6 of SCOMET — Reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Departments Notification dated 03.03.2021 on the above cited subject and to say that the End User Certificate format prescribed in Appendix IV(a) & IV(c) of SOP for grant of authorization under Part A & B, respectively, has been partially modified to harmonise with the EUC format prescribed by DGFT. The modified EUC formats are attached as annexure to this OM. Henceforth, applications filed under Part A & B of the SOP, accompanied with the modified formats shall only be considered for grant of export authorization.

2. Further, para 8(vii) of the SOP dated 3.3.2021 is also modified as under:

For	In case the parts/components exported by the Indian exporter are to be integrated into subsystems/systems by the foreign OEM/buyer for further exports and the latter is not willing to give EUCs due to confidentiality clause, then the Indian exporter shall obtain a declaration in EUC format as specified in Appendix-IV(c) from the Foreign OEM/buyer that the parts/components exported by the Indian exporter shall not be re-exported/diverted by the foreign OEM/buyer without following the export control system of the Government of that foreign OEM/buyer.
Read	In case the parts/components exported by the Indian exporter are to be integrated into subsystems/systems by the foreign OEM/buyer for further exports and the <u>final end-user of the integrated/processed products</u> is not willing to give EUCs due to confidentiality clause, then the Indian exporter shall obtain a declaration in EUC format as specified in Appendix-IV(c) from the Foreign OEM/buyer that <u>the integrated/processed products out of the parts/components</u> exported by the Indian exporter shall not be re-exported/diverted by the foreign OEM/buyer without following the export control system of the Government of that foreign OEM/buyer.
